New source - Initial startup after September 17, 2007. Initial startup is the time surface coating is first performed and equipment (e.g., spray booth) is first activated. **Employee must be initially trained and certified by July 7, 2008 or 180 days after hire, whichever is later (§ 40 CFR 63.11173 (g)(1)).**

Existing source - Initial startup prior to September 17, 2007. Initial startup is the time surface coating is first performed and equipment (e.g., spray booth) is first activated. **Employee must be initially trained no later than January 10, 2011 or 180 days after hiring, whichever is later (§ 40 CFR 63.11173 (g)(2)).**

Initial painter training may have been completed up to 5 years prior to the applicable training compliance date (see above). Initial training must include the hands-on and classroom training topics specified under 40 CFR §63.11173(f)(2)(i)-(iv) (described on page 2 of this certification form). *Note: If the owner/operator can show by documentation or certification that a painter's prior work experience or training is equivalent to the required training elements under 40 CFR §63.11173(f)(2), then the owner/operator is not required to provide initial training to that painter.*

Refresher Training and date: _____

Painter employees must be trained and recertified every 5 years, as required by 40 CFR §63.11173(3). **For refresher training, prior work experience alone cannot be used to meet the painter refresher training requirement. After the initial 5-years, all painters must receive hands-on and classroom refresher training on the required training topics every 5 years.**

Training Content and Documentation: Training must cover the following required training topics under 40 CFR § 63.11173(f)(2)(i)-(iv) and documentation of training must be attached (note: this required training may be completed via multiple courses).
